

A supplemental update sheet will be available sale day with up-to-date information. All announcements made from the auction block take precedence over printed matter in this sale book.

Breeding Guarantee:

All bulls have passed a breeding soundness exam. We will now offer to co-op with bull buyers to purchase Bull mortality & ASD Infertility insurance through Martin-Trudeau Insurance, Mitchell, SD. Seller will pay one half and buyer will pay one half of premium for coverage against death, infertility and injury. A representative of Martin Trudeau will be available sale day. If buyer declines this coverage he/she assumes full risk for bull. We would suggest that normal care still needs to be exercised toward these animals and particularly yearling bulls to maintain adequate body condition.

Accommodations and Delivery:

We will feed and keep bulls free of charge until April 15th. We encourage keeping bulls at the ranch to insure they receive all pre-breeding vaccinations, semen test, pour-on and de-wormer. Bulls can be delivered for free to buyers within a 400 mile radius. Outside of that area we can assist buyers with arranging transportation.



GUIDE TO GENETIC DATA

PRO S

Profitability and Sustainability is an all-purpose index that predicts average economic differences in all segments in the beef supply chain. This index is a combination of the breeding objectives modeled in the HerdBuilder and GridMaster selection indexes. In this index, replacement heifers are retained from within the herd and all remaining progeny are fed out to slaughter and sold on a quality-based grid. Traits included in this index include calving ease, growth, HPG, STAY, Mature Weight, Dry Matter Intake and carcass traits. The resulting index is expressed in dollars per head born (Index/High Value).

HB

HerdBuilder is a maternal selection index that predicts the economic differences of animals for traits that are important from conception through weaning. Expressed as dollars per head born, HB is calculated based on the scenario that bulls are mated to heifers and cows, replacement heifers are retained and all remaining progeny are marketed at weaning. Traits included in the HB index include Calving Ease Direct, Calving Ease Maternal, Weaning Weight, Milk, Mature Weight, Heifer Pregnancy and Stayability (Index/High Value).

GM

GridMaster is a selection index that predicts the average economic difference of non-replacement calves through the postweaning phase of production. GM places selection pressure on growth, feedyard performance and carcass traits. Expressed as dollars per head born, GM is calculated based on the scenario that progeny are fed out to slaughter and marketed on a quality-based carcass grid. Traits included in GM include Average Daily Gain, Carcass Weight, Dry Matter Intake, Marbling, Back Fat and Rib Eye Area (Index/High Value).

CED	Calving Ease Direct predicts differences in the percent of calves born unassisted out of 2-year-old dams. (Percent/High Value)
BW	Birth Weight predicts differences in actual birth weight of progeny. (Pounds/Low Value)
WW	Weaning Weight predicts differences in 205-day weaning weight. (Pounds/High Value)
YW	Yearling Weight predicts differences in 365-day yearling weight. (Pounds/High Value)
MILK	Milk predicts differences in weaning weight attributed to the milking ability of the animal's daughters. (Pounds/High Value)
STAY	Stayability predicts differences in the ability of an animals' retained daughters to remain productive in the herd – calve every year – through 6 years of age. (Percent/High Value)
MARB	Marbling predicts differences in marbling score – amount of intramuscular fat measured at the 13th rib. (Marbling Score Units/High Value)
REA	Ribeye Area predicts differences in square inches of ribeye area measured at the 13th rib. (Square Inches/High Value)

The sire of Lot 1, WEBR Red Revival 78H was the \$47,500 high seller out of the 2021 Bull Sale to our friends at Bayou Creek Ranch. This son of Red Six Mile Brando 666C was one of the most impressive breeding pieces we had raised in program history, and with this freshman class of sons we think you'll agree, his generating potential outreaches any expectations that came with his price tag and hype. These initiating sons of Red Revival 78H are built with both the phenotype selecting cowboy and sharp penciled cattleman in mind. WEBR Revival 203 is one that makes you stop and stare! Long and flexible spined, powerful from end to end, at the ground and up high, this beef bull stands up to the toughest selection criteria in the flesh. However his quality goes way beyond what you find on the outside of his cherry red hide. The carcass attributes that come embedded with the genomic package transform this power bull into a genetic masterpiece. He ratioed a 139 IMF against his large contemporary group, and is backed with a top 1% Ribeye Area ranking after his 50K genomically enhanced EPD panel was completed. All indicators of profitability point towards this elite herd sire.
